

In School Suspension Program Teacher

POSITION: In School Suspension Teacher

LOCATION: Oak Hill High School

REPORTS TO: Principal

In conjunction with S3 Grant specifications, this in school suspension position is an authorized departure from the regular school program designed to provide educational and social development for students whose disruptive behavior places them at risk of not succeeding in the traditional school structures and in adult life without positive interventions.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- West Virginia professional teaching certificate in secondary education, endorsed 9-12.
- Ability to effect positive behavior in disruptive students.
- Effective leadership and/or mentoring skills in working with youth.
- Successful experience in providing education to troubled or disruptive youth.
- Specialized training or experience in non-traditional programs.
- Specialized training in behavior management skills.
- Training in the use of computerized diagnostic and prescriptive education.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Instructional activities shall be consistent with the written curriculum and appropriate for the students' development levels.
- Curricular and instructional practices shall reflect high expectations for students.
- The instructional program shall be delivered in a climate conducive to learning.
- Sufficient instructional materials, supplies, and equipment shall be available to deliver the instructional program.
- The teacher shall comply with applicable state and federal laws and regulations in the education of exceptional students placed in the alternative education program.
- Maintains good professional work habits.
- Maintains and upgrades professional skills.
- Performs other duties as assigned by the supervisor.
