

# Itinerant Speech Language Pathologist

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- To help reduce or eliminate speech and hearing impediments that interferes with the individual student's ability to derive full benefit from the county's education program.
- Serve as a resource to school staff members in the development of a balanced program for oral communication and speech improvement.
- Provide a therapeutic program to meet individual needs of speech and hearing disabled children.
- Assist and guide teachers in observing, describing and referring suspected and identified speech and language impairments.
- Provide a thorough assessment and diagnosis of speech, voice, hearing and language impairments.
- Provide screening to identify speech disabled children at regular intervals and at specified levels.
- Provide information, support and counseling to parents and families when appropriate.
- Complete Medicaid billing as needed.
- Other duties as assigned by the immediate supervisor.

## **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Requires Masters Degree in Speech Pathology
- ASHA Certification required
