## Internet- Terms and Conditions

As a computer user, I agree to the following rules of the Acceptable Use Policy for the Computer Network and the Internet at Midland Trail High School.

I recognize that **all computer users have the same rights** to use the equipment; therefore,

1. I will not play games or use the computer resources for non-academic activities when others require the system for academic purposes.

I recognize that **software** is protected by copyright laws; therefore,

1. I will not make unauthorized copies of software found on school computers by copying them onto my own disks or onto other computers through electronic mail or bulletin boards.
2. I will not give, lend, or sell copies of software to others unless I have the written permission of the copyright owner or the original software is clearly identified as shareware or in the public domain (freeware).

I recognize that the **work of all users** is valuable; therefore,

1. **I will protect the privacy of others' areas by not trying to learn their passwords.**
2. I will not copy, change, read, or use files in another user's area without that user's permission.
3. I will not attempt to gain unauthorized access to system programs or computer equipment.
4. I will not create or introduce any virus, which may destroy files or disrupt service to other users.
5. I will not download, store, or print any files or messages that are profane, obscene, or that use language that offends or tends to degrade others.
6. I will not bring any removable storage devices into or take any disks out of the computer lab, unless school issued.

I recognize the computer networks are to be used as **educational tools** to support the mission of Midland Trail High School; therefore,

1. I will not transmit any materials in violation of the Federal or state regulation, including, but not limited to, copyrighted material, threatening or obscene material, or material protected by trade secret.
2. I will not use computer systems to disturb or harass other computer users by sending unwanted mail or by other means. I will not transmit private information about students or employees.
3. I will not use the network for commercial activities, product advertisements, or political lobbying.
4. I will not use the computer or my cell phone for sending personal messages, using texting, instant message, or personal emails, and etc. **(Ex. NO HOTMAIL, Yahoo, All social media, etc.)**
