RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Conducts and interprets physical therapy evaluations and submits report within timelines;
- Develops data-based Present Levels of Performance, goals and objectives for IEPs;
- Provides physical therapy services at assigned schools and locations throughout the county;
- Completes paperwork for Medicaid reimbursement in a timely manner;
- Participates in annual reviews, triennial reevaluations and revisions to IEPs as needed;
- Maintains individual therapy progress notes for use in developing IEP Progress Reports;
- Develops therapy schedule with the Director of Special Education and other physical therapy personnel;
- Consults with general and special education teachers, occupational therapists, parents and aides on supporting students' PT needs in the classroom, school and home environments as appropriate;
- Utilizes self-evaluation for the improvement of skills
- Provides professional development to teachers and support personnel as needed;
- Maintains professional work habits, communication skills and appearance;
- Maintains and upgrades professional skills; and
- Performs other duties as assigned.
