

POSITION: PLUMBER II
REPORTS TO: Director of Operations
DESCRIPTION: Personnel employed as a journeyman plumber.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. High school diploma or GED required.
2. Personnel must be or have been classified in this category, or must pass the state prescribed exam for this position.
3. Ability to work well with others.
4. Physical strength, dexterity, and ability to do manual labor.
5. Valid West Virginia driver's license.
6. Training through the formal apprenticeship or equivalent experience in plumbing crafts.
7. Required ability to interpret blueprint and plans and capacity for time and material.
8. Prefer formal schooling in plumbing with acceptable certificate of training.
9. Three to five years' experience in specialized plumbing crafts is preferred.
10. Plumbing license preferred.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Provides general repair, maintenance, and installation of utility lines and systems necessary for steam, hot water and forced-air heat, water, and sewage disposal in Fayette County School System facilities for the efficient maintenance and preventive maintenance of school system plants.
2. Must be able to rough in plumbing for new facilities or additions.
3. Provides project leadership on major plumbing projects.
4. Maintains equipment and tools necessary for plumbing craft work and maintains truck inventory as required by job assignments.
5. Plans and carries out preventive maintenance schedules as related to school plant plumbing systems.
6. Performs plumbing tasks in maintenance of plumbing systems with relation to other crafts in the Maintenance Department.
7. Plans job assignments as delegated by the Director of Operations and maintains records of materials and time on the job.
8. Performs general labor duties when assigned.
9. Plans for jobs from work orders and makes requisitions for supplies and materials.
10. Assists in providing training and in-service for maintenance and custodial personnel.
11. Maintains positive work habits.
12. Performs duties efficiently and productively.
13. Maintains and/or upgrades job-related skills.
14. Performs other related plumbing tasks as assigned by the Director of Operations.
15. Develops and maintains a safe work environment at all times.
