

POSITION: PAINTER

REPORTS TO: Supervisor of Maintenance

DESCRIPTION: Personnel employed to perform duties of painting, finishing, and decorating of wood, metal, and concrete surfaces of buildings, other structures, equipment, machinery, and furnishings of a county school system.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. High school diploma or GED required.
2. Personnel must be or have been classified in this category, or must pass the state prescribed exam for this position.
3. Ability to work well with others.
4. Physical strength, dexterity, and ability to do manual labor.
5. Valid West Virginia driver's license and CDL.
6. One to three years' experience as a painter preferred.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Paints any metal, wood, concrete, furniture, or plastered surfaces as required for all facilities in Fayette County School system; to preserve and enhance appearances; to maintain and operate the necessary equipment to perform this task.
2. Paints all surfaces, exterior as well as interior, of facilities.
3. Scrapes, cleans, patches, and caulks surfaces to prepare for a finished coat of paint.
4. Sandblasts for cleaning and preparation.
5. Strips with some small detail work.
6. Spray paints and finishes furniture.
7. Performs preventive maintenance by painting all facilities and equipment.
8. Maintains all tools and equipment used in the painting process.
9. Maintains job tools, time, and materials records.
10. Performs general labor duties when assigned.
11. Performs other related tasks as assigned by supervisor.
12. Maintains positive work habits.
13. Performs duties efficiently and productively.
14. Maintains and/or upgrades job-related skills.
15. Develops and maintains a safe work environment at all times.
