We are excited to announce the continuation of the W.E.B. and Booker T. Scholarship. Friends have donated funds that will be donated to Fayette County students by DuBois on Main in form of scholarships. Interested applicants will learn some of this little-known local history. We are excited for this opportunity to help further the education of Fayette County Students.

Two \$500 scholarships will be given to two students in Fayette County, West Virginia, based on a writing submission to DuBois on Main. The winners will be selected by the museum's scholarship committee and will be presented at an award ceremony in May. Students will submit their 500 word typed essay and related documents to **DuBois on Main, 116 Main St., Mount Hope, WV 25880.** *Include a bibliography of sources used. No plagiarizing will be tolerated.* This scholarship is for students who are attending a technical school as well as those that are college bound.

### **Writing Prompt:**

**Write about how the existence of DuBois High School has/has not affected your education in Fayette County relating such to the questions below:**

- **What are your goals in life?**
- **Why do you think it is important to have more than a high school education?**
- **What does getting this DuBois Scholarship mean to you?**

*(Hint! Scholars have only started to scratch the surface and publish pieces on DuBois High School History. Look at local sources, and call people if you have to.)*

Interested applicants will learn some of the little known history of DuBois High School, one of only two high schools in Fayette County for African American students until 1956.
