BRIDGING THE OPPORTUNITIES FOR A NATIONAL PARK— This academy features the New River Gorge Bridge, the New River and its water quality, real estate and sustainable structures in the gorge, and the possible growth in the tourism industry as a result of the area's new designation as a national park.

Weekly topics include a study of the bridge and creating a bridge by applying engineering design principles, visiting a local body of water to collect and test water samples, designing a sustainable cottage using design software, and planning tourism campaigns. Students will enjoy outings to the New River Gorge Canyon Rim Visitors' Center, the New River Watershed, and the Fayette Institute of Technology.
